



Cleveland Cornhole Team Bash III!

Cleveland, OH – February 15, 2015

The NASH – 3563 East 80th St. – Cleveland, OH - Slavic Village

**This event features not only teams of 4 players,
but TWO divisions, so start forming your team now!**

Each team will consist of 4 players. **You** decide who is on your team, but each division has rules about just how much “talent” can be on your team...

Division I – Maximum team skill level of 58

Division II – Maximum team skill level of 43 (No players valued 15 or higher may play in D2)

Your 4 player team may NOT exceed this total amount (based on which division you enter)

Time – Doors will open at 11am, registration CLOSSES AT NOON! Please note that this event is a **full day** event since we are basically running 3 tournaments on one day. Each player will be guaranteed 9 games! So there will be a ton of cornhole played!

Format:

- First up is the 4-man team competition. 4-player teams compete in a tournament as a team. 2 players from your team stand at one board and the other 2 players stand at the other board. Players will then pitch 2 bags per inning, rotating bags (first player on the team will throw the first and third bag while the second player would throw the second and fourth bag).
- Next is the doubles competition. Each 4-player team splits up into 2 doubles teams. Players are split based on the Cleveland Cornhole Rankings (top 2 players **MUST** play together). If players have the same ranking then the team can decide how to split those 2 players up (each bracket has one doubles team per 4-player team).
- Finally is the singles competition. Each team has players ranked 1-4 (based on Cleveland Cornhole rankings) and the #1 player goes into a bracket with all of the other #1 players from the other teams. #2 goes with all the other #2's, etc...
- Due to time constraints, if a Division has 9 or more teams, then each tournament will be “Holebrid” which is double elimination, but once a team loses, the best they can finish is 3rd place. If a division has 8 or fewer teams then it will be double elimination, but once you lose the best you can do is 2nd place (the team that goes undefeated in the winners bracket will be considered the champion of that particular sub-tournament).

Scoring:

- Scoring is based on the number of teams that enter each division.
Example: Eight teams enter Division 1. Then each tournament bracket would be worth a maximum of 11 points per team to the winner. Each bracket would award 11 points for 1st, 9 for 2nd, 7 for 3rd, 5 for 4th, 4 for 5th, 3 for 6th, 2 for 7th and 1 for 8th. For singles the points would be a straight 8/7/6/5/4/3/2/1. Then you total each teams points to determine an overall winner.

Entry Fee's

Division I - \$120/team (\$30/player)

Division II - \$80/team (\$20/player)

Prizes – 80+% overall payout in each Division!!!
