## Time

- Doors open at 1pm with registration closing for all social doubles at **2pm**.
- Registration for Pro, Advanced and Intermediate doubles closes at **3pm**.
- 4-Player Team Event starts as soon as all doubles ends.

## Format

- All tournaments are double elimination, **3-games guaranteed**

## Entry Fees

- Social and Intermediate doubles are \$20/team (\$10/player)
- Advanced doubles is \$30/team (\$15/player)
- Pro doubles is \$40/team (\$20/player)
- 4-player team is \$80/team (\$20/player)

## Prizes

- Social division winners will win trophies and small donated prizes
- Intermediate doubles is 50% total payout and trophies to the winner
- Advanced doubles is 60% total payout and trophies to the winner
- Pro doubles is 70% total payout and trophies to the winner
- 4-Player team event is 70% total payout and trophies to the winner

All money not paid out (including 100% of social division entries) goes directly to the RDA Competition Team. We will also be running a Chinese raffle and 50/50 raffle to help raise money for the Team.

## Pro/Advanced/Intermediate/Social Doubles Rules

**Pro Division** – No 2 Premier Level Players on a Team

**Advanced Division** – No Premier Level Players, a D1 level player can play with a D3 or lower player or two D2 level players can play together

**Intermediate Division** – No D1 Level Players, a D2 level player can play with a D4 or lower player or two D3 level players can play together

**Social Division** – No D3 or higher level players

## 4-Player Team Rules

For the 4 player team event each team has a “salary cap” of 10 points to spend on four players. Point values are as follows (player ratings can be found at <http://www.clevelandcornhole.com/player-classifications/>)

Premier – 4

Division I – 3

Division II – 2

Division III and lower – 1

**The only other restriction is no more than one premier player on a team.** So a “typical” team would have one premier, one D1, one D2 and one D3 player, but there is some flexibility if you want a different combo.

Games are played with 2 players on each end and they alternate pitching their teams bags. So if a player pitches the first bag for their team, then they also pitch the 3<sup>rd</sup> bag. The order you pitch your bags must remain the same throughout the game.
