



## A Different Way to Play March Madness!

### Introducing the Cleveland Cornhole Pick 6!

#### All You Do Is Pick 6 Teams

The Trick is Teams That are Seeded Lower (higher seed number) Earn You More Points

#### Details:

- \$10/Entry (2 Entries Per Person Max)
- 75% Payout
- 25% Goes to Help Pay Replace Our Old Cornhole Boards
- All entries **MUST** be submitted **AND PAID** for before **NOON** on Thursday March 15<sup>th</sup>
- All you do is submit 6 teams **AND** your guess as to how many points will be scored in the championship game which is used as a tiebreaker

#### How Is It Scored?

- Every game your team(s) win you earn the point value of their seed. So if you pick a team that is seeded #6 and they win, you get 6 points. If they win their 2<sup>nd</sup> game you get 6 more points. Plus you also earn bonus points based on which round the game is played. The tournament has 6 rounds so if a team wins their game in round 1 you get 1 bonus point. If they win in round 2 you get 2 additional bonus points and so forth.

**Example** – You pick a team that is seeded 7<sup>th</sup> and they win 3 games. You get 8 points for their round 1 win (7 is their seed plus round 1 is 1 bonus points). You get 9 points for their round 2 win (7 is their seed plus round 2 is 2 bonus points) and you get 10 points for their round 3 win. The team then loses in the 4<sup>th</sup> round so your total points earned from this team is 27. At the end you add up the points of all 6 of your teams and the highest score(s) win.

**In 2017 Chris Bules won by taking 2 #1 Seeds, 2 #2 Seeds, 1 #3 Seed and 1 #11 Seed (which made the Elite 8)**
