



# USA Forces Championships Qualifier!

## Blind Draws for Everyone Else Who Wants to Play

March 7, 2020

(Gym located at the very back of facility go past 1<sup>st</sup> 2 buildings – After pulling in the driveway, go all the way to the back)

**The USA Forces Championships will award a minimum of \$10,000 in prizes with the Final 8 teams playing on the NBC Sports Network!**

### Time

- **2:00pm** – Doors Open
- **3:00pm** – Registration Closes for USA Forces Qualifier and **First Blind Draw**  
Additional Blind Draws will be run until we reach 8pm or don't have enough players to run anymore, must be done by 10pm

### Divisions

- **USA Forces** – Doubles tournament. Open to all US Military Service Members (Active/ Retired/ Veteran with Honorable Discharge), Police, Fire, EMT (in a Public Service capacity). The service can be current or previous. Players **MUST** play with another player from the same branch/capacity of service. Only **ONE** Cornhole Pro (from any league) on a team!
- **Blind Draw** – anyone can play

### Entry Fees

- **\$2/Player** Cover Charge to Help Pay for Hall Expenses
- **USA Forces** – \$40/team (\$20/person)
- **Blind Draw** – \$10/person for the first tournament, \$5/person for all subsequent blind draws

### Prizes

- **USA Forces** – 1 bid (\$250 value) into the USA Forces Championships for every 6 teams that enter the qualifier!
- **Blind Draw** – 80% payout and ACL Local Points

### Format

- **USA Forces** – 2 games vs. random opponents, results seed a double elimination bracket (so 4 games guaranteed)
- **Blind Draw** – Double elimination

**Venue** – This is an indoor event, food and beer will be available for purchase. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK PERMITTED!**
